Matthew 9:12 & 13

The sick are the ones without Christ, they have not heard or received Christ into their lives.

When we are sick, we go to the Doctor, but how can the sick go if they don't know **how to**, **where to**, or **when to**, if we don't tell them.

The fear of hearing sirens and seeing an ambulance is that someone might have died.

Luke 23:38-43

Verse 39 Rejection This is the sick, but why is he sick.

Reasons Why He Might Be Sick

- Broken home life.
- Was never loved or accepted.
- Always had health problems.
- Was raised in an ungodly home.
- Lost a parent at a young age.
- Addictions stole his hope.
- Never really understood where he belonged

When telling someone about Jesus there may be layers of sickness and shame that keep them from accepting Jesus.

A Doctors role is to find the area of sickness in a person and then fix it, you go and be that Doctor.

You are the messenger of good news, the voice of Jesus Words, and you hold the key to their destiny.

Verse 40 Don't you fear God.

Fear is used here to show respect, honor, and gratefulness towards the one we love, Jesus.

Proverbs 19:23

The Results of Fear and Respect.

- It leads to life. John 10:10
- It leads to contentment, and peace. John 14:27
- It leads to Heaven. John 14:1-4

Proverbs 14:27

The fear or respect that we give Him and live for Him, and surrender to Him, points us towards home, Heaven.

Verse 42 The life changing moment, “Jesus remember me.”

Our job is to give others who are sick that same moment by telling them about Jesus, like someone who told us.

Verse 43 “Today you will be with me in paradise.”

Heaven and hell are not a science fiction movie, they are real.

Matthew 6:9 & 10

Two points here to get our eyes on Jesus who is in Heaven and to live our lives here on earth to get to Heaven.

Revelations 20:15

Hell is a place of eternal darkness, a fire that never dies, and a complete separation from God.

Matthew 8:12

Hell is not a place of laughter but of sorrow, remorse, and regret.

Hell reminds you of the times you turned away from Jesus, ran from Jesus and even mocked Jesus.

Luke 16:22-27

After reading these verses an alarm should be going off in your heads, who should I tell, who should I touch, and where should I go.

Once the sick enter hell there is no turning back, there is no more forgiveness, times up.

Fight for Heaven not hell, rescue those who are sick and need to be healed and made complete in Him.

Hell is a place where all you will know is the negative and the bad, there will be no pleasures.
