A siren or call are triggers to our emotions, feelings, and hearing to respond.

### **Matthew 28:16-20**

After His resurrection and proof of life to His disciples, He gave them this instruction. **Go and make disciples.**

**Matthew 28:20**

His assurance is that He is always with you to enable you, instruct you, and guide you in your journey for Him.

**Psalms 139:7-10**

No matter where you go, who you are with, God is always with you.

His purpose for being with you always is not to always look over your shoulder, but to give you assurance that you can do it.

He's the proud daddy in the stands watching you in this game of life assuring you that you can and will make it, do it, and win it for Him.
