- **He Enters into your Heart.**  
The Beginning of New Life.
- **He Enters into your Storms.**  
The Results of Peace, John 14:27
- **He Enters into your Lack.**  
The Beginning of Provision, Philippians 4:1
- **He Enters into the World to take us Home.**  
The Results of the Rapture.

When Jesus enters into events, your life, and this world, things change.

When Jesus appears or enters, there is a time of celebration and victory.

### Matthew 21:1-11

The entrance to this story was the beginning of His death and our new life and hope in Him.

His entrance was a sign of love to us and a sign of no turning back.

The assurance that we have is Jesus follows through with His Words and fulfills His Promises.

### II Corinthians 1:18-20

## The Significance of the Story.

- **The Donkey.**
